County Players Presents *Proof*

County Players continues its forty-eighth season with the award-winning play, *Proof* by David Auburn. Opening night will be Friday, February 3, 2006 at 8:00 PM at the Falls Theatre in Wappinger's Falls, NY. Subsequent performances will be February 4, 10, 11, 12, 17, and 18. Friday and Saturday performances begin promptly at 8:00 PM. The Sunday matinee performance (February 12) will be at 2:00 PM. Veteran director *Bill Peckham* couldn't be more pleased. "This is the best play to come out of New York in decades", says Peckham, "and I'm thrilled to have the opportunity to direct it."

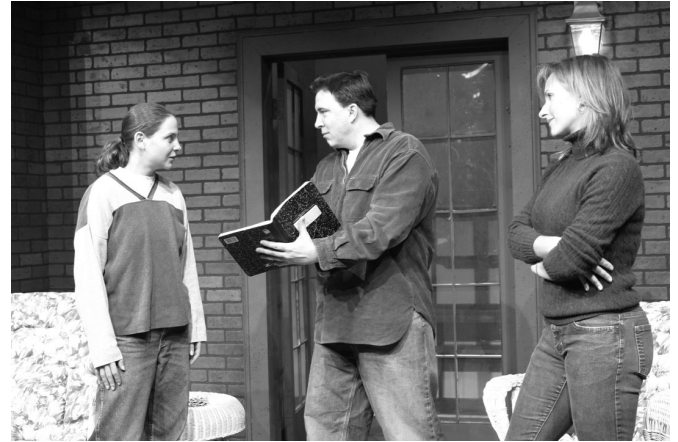
Following a successful run on Broadway, *Proof* walked away with a Tony Award and the Pulitzer Prize. This tightly structured, yet poetic drama centers around Catherine (*Janet Nurre*), a depressed and eccentric young woman in her 20's; Robert (*Paul Coleman*), her world famous mathematician father, with a history of mental illness; Hal (*Rick Meyer*), a graduate Math student who falls for Catherine; and Claire (*Maria Hickey*), her older sister from New York City.

The play opens on the night before Robert's funeral as his daughter, Catherine struggles with her loneliness and depression. She befriends Hal, a math geek and self-appointed guardian of Robert's notebooks. When her sister comes in from New York for the funeral, Catherine's future is in doubt. A groundbreaking proof surfaces, which sets off a mystery as to who the author may be. A battle for the truth explodes, threatening the family and Catherine and Hal's pending love affair.

"This play is a drama, a mystery, a comedy, and a romance all neatly wrapped into a compelling evening of theater", states Peckham, "and I am really fortunate to have four exceptional actors in these roles. It's been one of the most challenging pieces we've ever worked on. We have a dedicated production crew as well." Peckham also designed and built the set for County Players after much research on the internet. "I wanted the right atmosphere", he says, "so I found as much as I could about John Lee Beatty's Broadway set design and tried to recreate the spirit it added to the New York production."

Tickets are \$15 for adults and \$12 for seniors and children under 12 years of age. Call the box office at 845-298-1491 for reservations. Visa and MasterCard are accepted.

Ten Years Ago: In February 1996, County players produced the Neil Simon play *Brighton Beach Memoirs* directed by Lou Miressi. That show featured *Sean Donovan* as the lead (Eugene) and our president, *Anna Marie Martino* as Blanche.

Twenty Years Ago: In February 1986, County Players did not produce a show. At that time our seasons were less structured and the Board chose to put their efforts into the spring musical that year and skip the mid-winter production

Thirty Years Ago: In November 1976, County Players produced *The Secret Affairs of Mildred Wild* by Paul Zindel and directed by *Peter Edman*. This obscure play, which had a total of twenty-three performances on Broadway, dealt with a woman's retreat into fantasy after facing her husband's infidelity and the imminent loss of her home to urban renewal. Our leading lady, *Peggy Berenotto*, had also played Electra in *Gypsy*. We will be producing *Gypsy* again this spring!
